Overview

The proposed new rider would prohibit the transfer of funds out of Goal B, Secure Texas.

Required Actions:

- 1. On page X-3 in Article X of the Conference Committee Report for House Bill 1, amend the following rider:

Long Term Revenue and Cost Drivers Report. The Legislative Budget Board shall deliver a report on long term revenue and cost drivers for the state budget to the ~~Eighty-fourth~~^{Eighty-fifth} Legislature. Information in the report will cover the ten fiscal years beginning September 1, 2017 and ending August 31, 2027. The Legislative Budget Board will consult with the State Demographer and the Comptroller of Public Accounts to produce a report that summarizes the impacts of forecasted state economic and demographic growth on state finances for each article of the General Appropriations Act. The Eighty-fifth Legislature shall determine the benefit of continuing such an evaluation.
