



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State Office of Administrative Hearings Selected Fiscal and Policy Issues

1. In June of 2012, the State Auditor's Office (SAO) issued a report on Selected Financial Controls at the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH). The report discussed areas needing improvement in SOAH's budget development methodology. These include higher accuracy in the agency's methods of tracking the costs of providing services by method of finance and in anticipating funding needs across multiple methods of finance for providing future services based on projected case loads. LBB recommendations continue agency funding at approximately 2012-13 levels in alignment with agency's request and include additional reporting requirements in the agency's Hearings Activity Report rider in alignment with the SAO's recommendations (see Rider Highlights #5).
