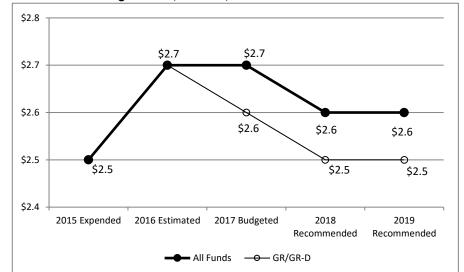

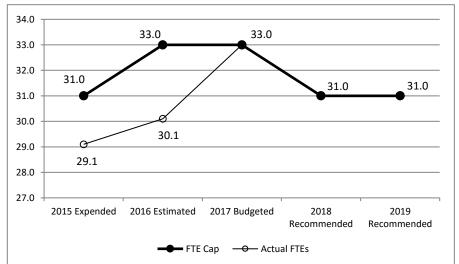

Board of Plumbing Examiners Selected Fiscal and Policy Issues - House

1. Funding for Enforcement Efforts. Due to the elimination of two Investigators for the four percent reduction in the 2018-19 biennium, the agency is anticipating increased expenses for travel, fuels, lubricants, and vehicle maintenance, as the remaining Investigators will travel longer distances to inspect job sites and investigate complaints. The agency reallocated \$23,000 from funds received in fiscal year 2016 for a one-time vehicle purchase for this purpose in its base request. Recommendations include the \$23,000 in General Revenue for this purpose in the 2018-19 biennium and includes the reduction for the one-time vehicle purchase.
