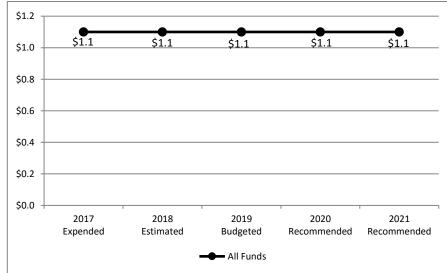

The Health Professions Council (HPC) is funded entirely through Interagency Contracts with agencies participating in HPC's shared services.

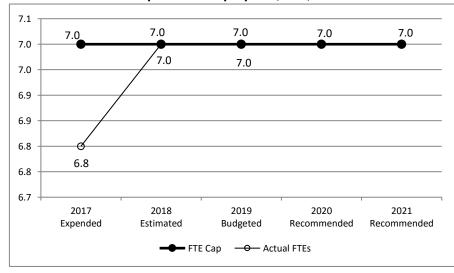
The bill pattern for this agency (2020-21 Recommended) represents an estimated 100% of the agency's estimated total available funds for the 2020-21 biennium.

Health Professions Council Selected Fiscal and Policy Issues - House

- 1. **Shared Regulatory Database.** The Health Professions Council (HPC) transitioned from using data center services through the Department of Information Resources (DIR) in fiscal year 2016 and is now supported by a vendor, Micropact. The agency re-entered a contract with DIR in which DIR oversees the contract with Micropact and provides database hosting services through data center services. Both DIR and Micropact costs are increasing for the 2020-21 biennium, and Board recommendations include an increase in the agency's appropriation for DIR cost increases but not for the increase in cost with the vendor, Micropact (see Summary of Funding Changes and Recommendations A and Items Not Included in Recommendations #1).
- 2. Total Funding Allocation for Member Agencies. Board recommendations include funding for Health Professions Council with a net increase of \$54,323 for longevity pay (in administration and support and website administration) and an increase in data center services costs with the Department of Information Resources. Member agencies agree to the defined services provided and their respective share of costs for the services prior to submission of HPC's Legislative Appropriations Request. A breakdown of HPC's funding by service is below.
