- 1) Amounts for 2022-23 include federal funding provided by Senate Bill 8, Eighty-seventh Legislature, Third-called Session, 2021, for behavioral health including \$40.0 million for the Texas Facilities Commission to construct the Permian Basin Behavioral Health Center; \$237.8 million for the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) for the construction of the Dallas State Hospital; \$15.0 million for HHSC to expand capacity at the Sunrise Canyon Hospital; and \$113.1 million for the Higher Education Coordinating Board: Texas Child Mental Health Care Consortium. Not all Senate Bill 8 funding is expected to be fully expended in the 2022-23 biennium.
- 2) Amounts at HHSC include a decrease of \$166.2 million in Other Funds associated with onetime construction and deferred maintenance projects at mental health state hospitals.
- 3) Estimated Medicaid and CHIP expenditures include projected cost growth that is not funded in 2024-25 recommendations.
- 4) Amounts do not include behavioral health funding currently recommended for the fiscal year 2023 supplemental appropriations bill, which includes funding for new inpatient capacity including \$477.0 million for the Panhandle, \$452.0 million for Rio Grande State Center, \$696.0 million for Terrell State Hospital, \$696.0 million for North Texas State Hospital Wichita Falls, and \$2.8 million for state hospital vehicle funding.
