

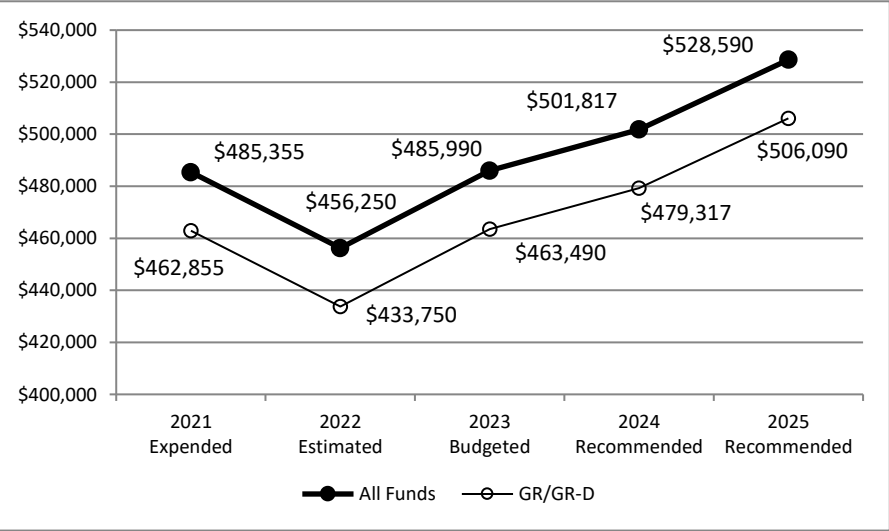

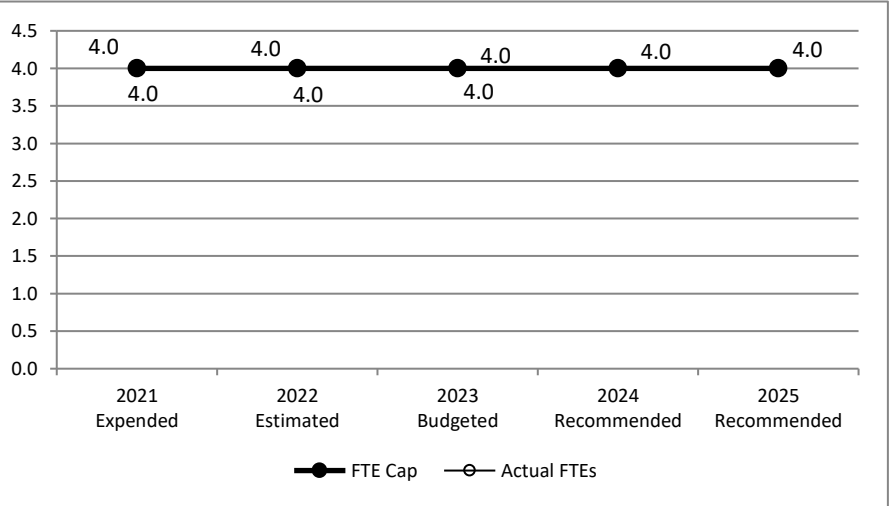

Selected Fiscal and Policy Issues - House**

1. **State Prosecutor Salary.** The State Prosecuting Attorney's salary is linked by Government Code §46.003 to a district judge's with comparable years of service under the tiered, tenure-based compensation structure established by Government Code §659.012. Recommendations include \$0.3 million in estimated General Revenue funding for the State Prosecuting Attorney's compensation that includes \$10,922 above 2022-23 spending levels to cover the salary, benefits, and longevity cost increases pursuant to an increase in the State Prosecuting Attorney's tenure during the 2024-25 biennium. (See also, Appendix A.)
2. **State Representation Funding.** Recommendations continue All Funds appropriations at 2022-23 spending levels to represent the state in all proceedings conducted by the Court of Criminal Appeals. The agency also reviews all Court of Appeals decisions that are negative to the state for their impact on statewide jurisprudence. This includes \$0.6 million in General Revenue funds and \$45,000 in Interagency Contracts for services provided by the Office of Court Administration.
3. **Unexpended Balance Authority.** Recommendations continue the agency's Unexpended Balance authority but remove the strategy-level designation in the bill pattern and include a new Special Provisions – Judiciary rider providing the same authority for all Article IV courts and agencies.
