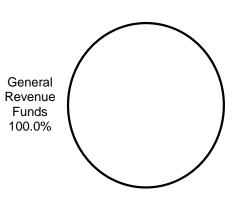

RECOMMENDED FUNDING BY METHOD OF FINANCING



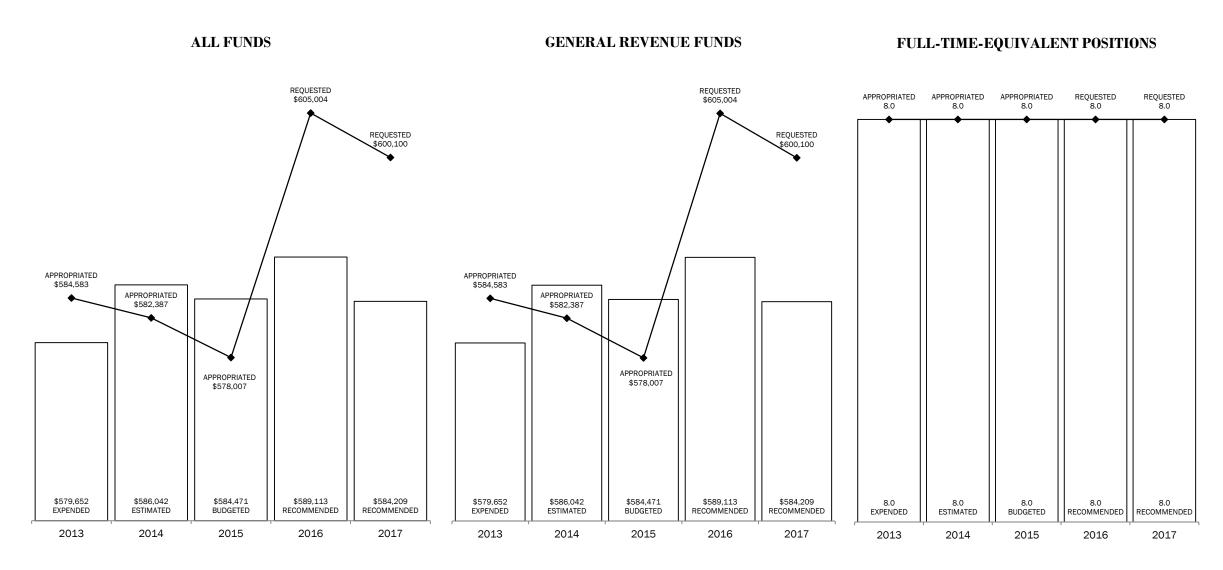
