



### Office of the State Prosecuting Attorney Selected Fiscal and Policy Issues - Senate

1. **Judicial Compensation Commission**: The Judicial Compensation Commission is recommending a 10.2 percent increase in judicial salaries and for prosecutors whose salaries are statutorily linked to the state salary of a district judge for the 2018–19 biennium. This would increase the salary of the State Prosecuting Attorney from \$143,500 to \$158,137. The most recent judicial salary adjustment was a 12 percent increase in the 2014–15 biennium for judge and prosecutor positions linked to district judge pay totaling \$34.8 million across the 2014–15 biennium.
